

Travelling to school on school transport

Parents/carers to wait at designated bus stop with children.

The expectation from County is for parents/carers to wait for up to 20 minutes past the allocated time (see Appendix A) .

Bus arrives on time

Parent/carer ensures child/children safely board designated school transport.

Children arrive on designated school transport at the front of the school.

A designated member of school staff will escort the children into school.

Bus does not arrive at allocated time

Bus Company/LA will contact school if the delay is more than 20 minutes.

School will ring the first contact at each bus stop to relay information.

Parents/carers to make the decision as whether to continue to wait or bring their child to school.

No parent/carer should transport another child to school unless they have permission from the child's parent/carer. The school do not take responsibility for other parents/carers transporting other children to school. The school's responsibility for your child only starts when they alight from their designated school transport at the front of the school.
